Updated publication rules (May 8th, 2017)

I would kindly inform you that the publication rules have been revised by the General Assembly in December 2016. The relevant information was circulated in the NEWSBrief #Issue <http://users.euro-fusion.org/general-info/newsbrief/>

“As a response to the simplification needs of the community, the General Assembly has revised the general principles and guidelines relating to publications or public communication under EUROfusion. In the previous version of the publication procedures it was mandatory to upload posters and presentations to all conferences and workshops to the EUROfusion pinboard; now this only holds for major conferences on a predefined list that has been added as an Annex to the publication rules. This list includes conferences that are typically attended by more than 10 EUROfusion scientists. Workshops and work meetings have been excluded from the list as these have a more informal character.

The revised rules also clarify the role of the Department Heads in the endorsement procedure empowering them to act as endorsed if the Project or Task Force Leader fails to endorse the contributions in due time.

The General Assembly has also acknowledged that displaying posters is not always possible, therefore the amended rules incorporate simplifications such that posters can be rehearsed in Task Force / Project Team meetings or displayed at the facility, rather than making the poster displaying mandatory.

most significant changes:

Cleared manuscripts of journal papers, conference papers (with or without referee) are archived by default in the open access online repository, while other document types such as reports, posters and presentations will only be made public on the explicit request of the authors. The peer reviewed versions of the refereed articles, more precisely the corrected and accepted versions of the manuscripts where the authors included the comments from the referees, but without the journal special formatting will also be deposited in the open access repository in line with the requirements of the EC and of the publishers.

In case the PL/TFL/WPLs fail to endorse the publication in the allotted time, this responsibility is transferred to the PMU Department Heads

Oral and poster presentations at conferences listed in the Annex, should be submitted on the pinboard at the latest on the day of the rehearsal. In case the poster or presentation is modified between the submission and final presentation, the new version should be uploaded to replace the original version. Oral and poster presentations at other conferences and workshop may be uploaded to the pinboard on a voluntary basis.

new system (IMS) for mission application and approval

Dear Colleagues,

As I told you the updated Mission module is available on <https://ims.euro-fusion.org> [ims.euro-fusion.org].

Attached you will see the instructions, which might be sent to your project participants.

You as the Principal investigator will need to validate the applications on the project home page. Therefore after you log in to IMS please switch the "View" on the top to Project Leader, you will find all applications under "Project Mission Applications" tab.

You can "Approve/Reject/Request Changes" even from the table directly (there are small buttons at the end of each line) or by going inside the application for more detailed information (double click on it), then the same buttons must be repeated there.

Please remember that the mission module is just delivered to us by the software development company. Therefore, if you will find some errors/inconsistencies or have comments about it – please send them to me. I will conduct it to developers.

In principle we do not request you to copy all retrospective missions to the new system. But since there are not so many missions performed yet it would be easier for you ask people to re-submit it in the system and re-approve it.

The advantage is that you will have the entire mission statistic in the single place."

When you are logged to IMS (<https://ims.euro-fusion.org/>), you can apply for mission on the top menu:

“Actions/Apply for mission”

Follow mission application wizard and submit it for the approval of your project leader.

Mission application wizard will navigate you and automatically fill most of required information based on records in IMS (If you noticed that the choice of the system is wrong, you are allowed to correct it manually)

Fields marked with * are obligatory

If there is a select field, you can scroll with the mouse through the list or start typing – IMS will suggest possible chooses for you

When you complete a certain part of application – please proceed further with the “**Next**” button

You also can use “**Previous**” button to return

Tab. General information:

IMS will prefill the name from your login, but you need to select the Work Package

If your mission must be linked with the particular deliverable (and we already have the record for this deliverable in IMS, you can select it from drop-down list, but since many WPs are not up to date on IMS we do not recommend you to do it, just leave it “Not linked...”)
